

## You Tube Translations Overview

The process for translations is managed by the user. Translations are created by Google Translate. If a user needs the captions in a language other than English (the default language), they will click on the closed-captioning icon, then select the language of their choice.

### Step 1:

To view Closed Captioning (CC) in Spanish (or any other language):



User clicks on the CC button to turn on captioning (button has a red underline when CC is on)

### Step 2:



User clicks on the 1) Gear to show CC options, then 2) the Subtitles/CC Arrow to show



the Auto-Translate option. Clicking that will show numerous language options. The user selects the language they desire and the CC will be auto-translated.

**NOTE:** Translations are created via Google translate of the closed captioned text. There is no expectation that the translation is 100% accurate, nor the English closed captioning, unless you have made any necessary edits to the captioning file.
