Trust Land Updates-(Mr. Stromberg)

- Carry over from previous year is \$46,000. This is higher amount due to COVID
- School purchased 25 additional computers and provide one teacher to assist with Davis Connect. Cost will be approximately \$18,000.
- Teachers may be asked to assist with remediation during their productivity class. Remediation isn't an entire term commitment.
- Possibly add another study skills class in January.
- Continue with our English/Math tutors starting in October.
- Do an outreach to parents/students who may need additional help or may not be attending school.
- **Trust Land Grants** - One teacher has applied for trust land grant. Mr. Stromberg will send out an additional reminder to teachers.

School Improvement Plan

- Mr. Stromberg will provide a trust land summary which will be available in the fall. The report will reflect trust land expenses from the prior school year and to be sent to the community council members.
