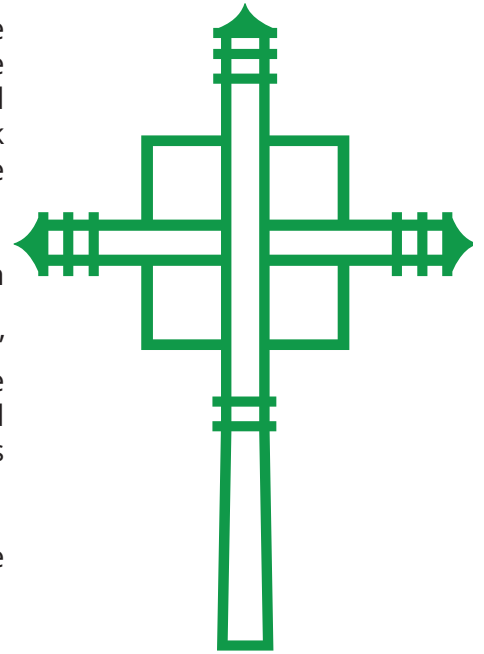
GOSPEL VALUE: PERSEVERANCE
