SCHOOL DAY

CURRICULUM

Over 150 classes (many honors level) offered in English, history, math, science, modern language, arts, PE, and computer science. Students can also enroll in classes offered by the Global Online Academy, of which Catlin Gabel is a founding member

ADVISORY

Small, mixed-grade groups (C&Cs) meet daily with faculty advisors

ADDITIONAL SUPPORT

Staffing includes two librarians, two personal counselors, two college counselors, and The Learning Center team

CONFERENCES AND FEEDBACK

Conferences in November; written reports in January, April, and June

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

Students engage in various ways across Portland including service work, internships, Startup Camp, and PLACE (People Leading Across City Environments)

LEADERSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

Student government, affinity groups, Diversity Summit, clubs, and more

ATHLETICS

Cross-country, soccer, volleyball, basketball, skiing, swimming, track and field, baseball, golf, and tennis are offered. Students who play sports outside of CG are supported in these endeavors

CLUBS

Over 50 student-initiated and run clubs. Offerings vary from year to year, but examples include: Science Bowl, Model UN, Mock Trial, Chess Club, Yearbook, Taiko Club, Engineering & Robotics, and Yoga

SENIOR PROJECT

All students complete a month-long project, most often an internship at a local non-profit or business

COLLEGE OUTCOMES

Graduates attend a range of schools including Ivy League colleges, selective small colleges, state universities, engineering programs, and art institutes
