Meals will feature foods that are cooked and prepared by staff in Edison School District kitchens. The menu will consist of classic cold items as well as popular entrees that will be chilled and served cold to be taken home and reheated. Heating instructions will be provided.



### Who Qualifies

All children 18 or younger who are students in the district are eligible to participate  
All students are eligible to pick up meals at their enrolled site or any other school they choose.



### Cost

Meals are free for all eligible children.



### Meal Pickup Process

Parents or caregivers may pick up student meals, even when the child is not present, by given your students name and ID number at the point of meal service pick up.

Parents will be asked to sign their students name and ID on the table for staff to review.

Meals will be placed on our table for contactless parent pick up.



### How to Register

### Associate Safety

In addition, CDC and FDA procedures are in place to protect school nutrition staff and the students they serve, including the use of Personal Protective Equipment, additional cleaning of food preparation and service areas and regular training on proper hygiene practices and food safety measures.
