We would like to welcome all potential 2020/2021 Carmel Middle School Basketball Cheerleaders and Families. Tryouts this year will be held Tuesday, October 27th and Wednesday October 28th from 5-7:30pm in the Carmel Middle School, Scott Center Gym.

Tuesday October 27th- Day 1 (Tryout Clinic)- You will learn a cheer, 2 chants and a dance in addition to working on other common cheerleading skills (motions, jumps, tumbling, stunting).

- *Please Turn in the Information Sheet and Cheer Contract on this day! (Forms are available under the "Required Forms" link on the Athletics webpage)*
- *Please wear a t-shirt, shorts, and gym shoes (No tank tops). Have hair pulled into a ponytail.*

Wednesday October 28th- Day 2 (Tryout Day)- There will be a short time to practice before tryouts begin this day.

- *Please wear a PLAIN WHITE T-SHIRT and BLACK SHORTS for tryout day, with hair in a ponytail (Game Day Ready Look).*
- *Coaches will meet individually with athletes beginning around 7pm to announce the 2020/2021 squad. After this, students must be picked up promptly.*

****Times may vary depending on the number of cheerleaders trying out. We will do our best to keep communication open this day for a more accurate pick up time!***

Season Info and Estimated Costs

Should your cheerleader make the squad, below is a brief rundown of what to expect this season.

- Practices will be held Tuesday and Thursday evenings from 5-6:15pm (*this time is subject to change at the discretion of the coaching staff*).
- Expected (approximate) Expenses:
 - 1 pair of Briefs: \$14
 - 2 body suits (1 white/1 blue): \$25
 - Shoes: \$25
 - Bow: \$8
 - Poms: \$25
 - Squad t-shirts/sweatshirts: \$15-60 (optional)
