Cohort and Teachers


- Homerooms remain unchanged (if possible)
- Homeroom = cohort
- Cohorts: max. 12-16 students
- **Students at home** belong to their homerooms and attend their classroom virtually via google meet (bidirectional)
- All lessons are taught in the designated homeroom classrooms
- Teachers don't belong to any cohort (are isolated from students)

Structure

- Wednesday is always online day
 and at the same time in grades 7 and 8 Mountain View day for SF 7 & 8
- Lessons on campus Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday mornings from 8am to 1pm, three double hours a day at 100-minute blocks
- after an extended break for the drive home and lunch break,
 some additional lessons online,
 mainly as free work with the support of subject teachers in grade 5..10
- new schedule after the fall break
- no PE in grades 5..10
- no homework policy remains in place



Breaks

- 15 minute breaks within 100 minute block at designated places and times
- on courts and fields, designated areas on field

Classrooms/ Openair-Classrooms

- Teachers can teach their classes outdoors when possible.
- We will provide tent-areas for M and H
- All students must sit in one assigned spot in the assigned outside area to allow for social distancing.
- Technical challenges could arise best for independent and off-screen work











Mixed learning groups

- Challenge: we cannot mix two cohorts!
- Advantage: mixing is possible online (during the online day and in the afternoons)
- Challenge: not all subjects fit into the online learning slots
 - German/DaZ and English/ESL
 - 2. Spanish/French
 - 3. Mathe Plus
 - 4. Sport



German/DaZ and English/ESL

- Online: DaZ/ESL-teacher can work with mixed groups
 - weekly lessons dedicated to language acquisition (Sprachstunde)
 - Same as during DL
- On-campus: DaZ/ESL-teacher may work with students from one class separately
 - o e.g. mondays 8a, thursday 8b
- Alternative: online-support
 - e.g. Professional assessment, individualized support, Testing accommodations,
 Specialized error monitoring



Exams

High School:

- students on campus will take exams as usual
- students that do not attend classes on campus
 can come to campus to take exams or can take exams online at home
- exam plan will be adapted to new schedule

Middle School:

- Complex assignments (e.g. open book exams) will continue in most subjects
- written exams are possible in main subjects (2nd quarter)
- Students who are not on campus for the exam, need a printer, a camera which works, good internet and a signed consent form from parents and student.

Drop-off and Pick-up

Please drive to the Zone pertaining to your grade - see below if you have children elementary and secondary they can exit at the same zone.

Have health screening result ready to show drop off support staff If you have more than one child - make screenshots of health screening before leaving home so that you can just flip through them quickly.

If you cannot show a completed health screening, your child will not be allowed to go to school on campus that day. This should be completed before you leave your house, preferably by 7:30.

Please stay in vehicle and have your child ready to exit the vehicle when you reach the zone.

If you would would like to park outside of campus and walk your child to campus, your waiting time, could be shorter. **Older children may come in on their own**, but need screen shot of the health screening on their phone.




Illustration 3: Comparison of COVID-19 transmission probability with and without masks (East Alabama Medical Center)

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Checklist

For ALL students:

- Please provide printer at home
 - Students need access to the printer
 - Printer must have ink and paper

Students who attend campus, need to bring:

- Masks (mind. 2 per day)
- Name tags for all their equipment (box with material can stay in classrooms)
- Headphones
- <u>Fully</u> charged lpad/Laptop
- Enough water (no access to water fountains)
- Snacks (all microwaves are removed)
- Sunscreen and hats (less shade available)
- adequate clothing (sweaters, jackets, warm shoes, rain gear, etc.) for when the temperatures will drop.
