BAM (Becoming A Man)

Becoming A Man is a program for young men in grades 7-12. BAM groups meet every week during school time with a BAM counselor, who supports the group in developing six core values: Integrity, Accountability, Self-Determination, Positive Anger Expression, Respect for Womanhood, and Visionary Goal-Setting.

BAM is an experience. It is a powerful place to connect with other young men and explore new skills and ideas.

Here's what some of our current BAM participants have to say about it:
"I have gained so much in this program but one thing that stood out to me is becoming a leader."
"[I learned about] integrity. I learned a lot from it while having fun, and that doesn't usually happen for me at school."
"[The BAM counselor] started a whole group that led to a whole friendship and family."
"[I participate in BAM] to learn more about how to get through life as a male in this time."
