Community Council Minutes 10/8/2020

1. A motion was made to approve the meeting minutes from the previous meeting. The minutes were approved with the addition of members who were present.
2. Vice Chair elections were held and Brenda Bacon was the sole nominee. Brenda was unanimously elected.
3. The rules of order were provided in a handout. David Stringfellow moved to adopt a document for simplified standards of rules and procedures. A draft will be created and provided to all members and guests. The procedures will be concise and clear. David will create the draft and share it with council prior to the meeting in November. The motion was unanimously approved.
4. Brett Sims presented on the COVID publication of cases for the district and school. Positive case numbers within a 14-day period are reported. The numbers are updated weekly.
5. Students have done well keeping their masks on. The regulations related to athletic teams are that if there are 3 positive cases on one team, the health department and the district will have a discussion on who will quarantine.
6. Once a positive test is received by the school from the Health Department, the school will initiate contact tracing as needed. Seating charts, coaches' statements, and interviews are reviewed. If a student has been in contact with a Covid positive student within 6 feet for a period longer than 15 minutes they will be quarantined. A motion was made to publish information regarding the quarantine process on the school website or in an email. The motion was approved.
7. Principal Swanson made a clarification that the community council should feel comfortable bringing anything up in community council. The council can make recommendations, but they are not a binding action with the exceptions of Land Trust money and digital safety.
8. CE courses are becoming very difficult under the hybrid model. Department chairs will be meeting regarding this issue and will work on solutions. A discussion was held on possible solutions.
9. A motion was made to adjourn the meeting. The motion was approved.
