



FOR PARENTS: DEVICES USED FOR ON-SITE INSTRUCTION



MY CHILD HAS A PERSONAL DEVICE

- Students are *encouraged* to bring personal devices from home to be used for classroom instruction.
- Students who bring personal devices must abide by the District's [Bring Your Own Device \(BYOD\) Policy](#).
- The district is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged personal devices.
- Students may not share their personal device with other students.
- Students must charge their devices at home each day.

MY CHILD HAS A DISTRICT DEVICE

- Students are *required* to bring district-owned devices from home to be used for classroom instruction *unless* the device is being used by a Duncanville ISD sibling who is learning from home.
- Students must continue to abide by the district's [Acceptable Use Policy](#)
- Students may not share their district-owned loaner device with other students.
- Students must charge their devices at home each day.

MY CHILD DOES NOT HAVE A DEVICE

- Students who do not have a personal or district-owned loaner device will be provided with the opportunity to use district-owned devices as appropriate when at school.
- Shared devices will be sanitized between uses for each child.
