

Declaration of Intent for Equivalency Credits 2020-2021

To earn academic equivalency credits at Puget Sound Skills Center (PSSC), a student <u>first</u> must be enrolled in the Career & Technical Education (CTE) program listed below for a <u>minimum of two semesters</u> AND earn full credit with a "C" or above for both semesters. <u>Second</u>, a student who signs up for these credits may be required to complete additional academic work to meet the curriculum requirements. The sending school counselor will determine how equivalency credit will meet graduation requirements. The declaration forms are due to the PSSC instructor within the first semester of the student's enrollment in a PSSC CTE program. A student may earn each of the equivalency credits available one time only over the entire course of their PSSC enrollment.
