\*\*Students receiving a flu shot during school hours must have a consent form signed prior to the appointment time. This will be emailed to you. For after-school appointments, students must have a parent or guardian present.

Flu shots are free. Donations are not required, however, they do help provide flu shots to more students in the White Bear Lake Area School District.

### Wednesday, October 14 is a School Day

Reminder - Wednesday, October 14 will be a regular school day. Hybrid A-K will be in school, distance A-K will log into classes, hybrid and distance L-Z will work independently at home.

A revised district calendar was approved at the September 14 School Board meeting. In the revised calendar, three of the four days originally scheduled as school days September 5-8, 2020 will be made up on the following days, which were non-school days on the original 2020-21 calendar:

- Wednesday, Oct. 14
- Friday, Feb. 12 (at-home learning day)
- Monday, April 5

### Quarter 1 Grades for Periods 1-3

The last day of Quarter 1 for periods 1-3 was October 9. All work for Quarter 1, periods 1-3 must be turned in by October 23. Grade options are A, B, C, D, I and NG. An "I" indicates that the student has earned less than 60% of the points, and the student may still turn in work to improve the grade. At the end of the quarter, grades listed as "I" (incomplete) may be changed to "NG" (no grade). An "NG" indicates that the student has not provided enough evidence of progress to earn a grade.
