

## RETURN TO LEARN 2020

ONCE THE COUNTY-WIDE ILLNESS SPREAD IS REACHED AT EACH LEVEL, A SYSTEMATIC REVIEW OF LOCAL METRICS WILL BE CONDUCTED WITH PUBLIC HEALTH OFFICIALS, INCLUDING ILLNESS SPREAD BY SCHOOL ZONE, CLUSTERING DATA, AND ABSENTEEISM OF STUDENTS AND STAFF. THIS REVIEW WILL DETERMINE WHICH INSTRUCTIONAL SCENARIO WILL BE USED.

### **MINIMAL SPREAD**

County Infection Rate Less Than 0.5%

#### **IN-PERSON LEVEL 1**

Students on campus or online • Proper hygiene and building cleaning practices emphasized • Nurses or designee monitor reportable illness and encourage self-reporting • Hand-washing emphasized before/after classes and activities • Social distancing maintained as feasible • Disposable/Cloth face coverings worn by staff, students and visitors while on school property except as follows: when an individual cannot safely wear a face covering, while eating and drinking, while indoors and maintaining social distancing (under direction of FSSD staff), and while outdoors and maintaining social distancing (under direction of FSSD staff) • Students, faculty and staff screened prior to building entry • Educational and mass gathering spaces socially distanced.

### **MODERATE SPREAD**

County Infection Rate 0.5% – 1%

#### **IN-PERSON/VIRTUAL - LEVEL 2**

Buildings at reduced capacity • Select small groups of students may attend on campus (e.g. special education, English Learners, students requiring intense academic and/or behavioral intervention, and pre-kindergarten through second grade). Remote Instruction will be in place for all other students • Proper hygiene and building cleaning practices emphasized • Nurses or designee monitor reportable illness and encourage self-reporting • Hand-washing emphasized before/after classes and activities • Disposable/Cloth face coverings worn by staff, students and visitors while on school property except as follows: when an individual cannot safely wear a face covering, while eating and drinking, while indoors and maintaining social distancing (under direction of FSSD staff), and while outdoors and maintaining social distancing (under direction of FSSD staff) • Students, staff and visitors screened prior to building entry • Educational and mass gathering spaces socially distanced.

### **SUBSTANTIAL SPREAD**

County Infection Rate Greater Than 1%

#### **VIRTUAL - LEVEL 3**

Most students learning remotely • Select small groups of students may attend on campus (e.g. special education, English Learners, students requiring intense academic and/or behavioral intervention) • Proper hygiene and building cleaning practices emphasized for those on campus • Nurses or designee monitor reportable illness and encourage self-reporting • A disposable/cloth face covering must be worn by all staff, students and visitors while on school property except as follows: when an individual cannot safely wear a disposable/cloth face covering, while eating and drinking, while indoors and maintaining social distancing, at the direction of FSSD staff, and while outdoors and maintaining social distancing, at the direction of FSSD staff • Staff, students, and visitors screened prior to building entry.
