

Textiles (Art, Craft and Design)

Aims of the Subject

This course is designed to consolidate the existing skills, knowledge and understanding gained by students at Key Stage 4 and to offer them the opportunity to make a personal response to new experiences of a practical and conceptual nature.

Students will be given the opportunity to develop:

- their intellectual, imaginative and creative powers
- their investigative, analytical, experimental, practical, technical and expressive skills, their aesthetic understanding and critical judgement
- their understanding of the relationships between art and design and an awareness of the contexts in which they operate
- their knowledge and understanding of art and design in contemporary society and in other times and cultures
- an awareness of different roles, functions and audiences and consumers of art, craft and design practice.

Course Description

There are two assessed parts in Eduqas GCE Art, Craft and Design:

Part 1 - Personal Investigation – a coursework portfolio, practical outcome and written element (60% of A-Level grade)

Part 2 - Externally Set Assignment - a preparation portfolio and an outcome from fifteen hours' focused supervised work. (40% of A-Level grade)

Entry Criteria

GCSE Grade 6 or above in Design and Technology (Textiles specialism) or Art and Design plus a Grade 5 or above in English.
