Dear Parents/Guardians,


Please take a few minutes to review the link for the [Return to School](#) page on our district website. Pay particular attention to the hybrid schedules that have been refined. We are grateful for your understanding and patience as we safely prepare for our return to in-person instruction for those who selected that option for the first marking period. As we continue to strive to provide superlative educational programming while still mitigating the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic, things sometimes change quickly, and we encourage you to check our website regularly. Specific questions about your child's scheduling should be directed to the building principal.

For the students returning to in-person instruction on October 19, 2020, they will either be attending four days per week or two days per week via a single session model. All students will be totally remote on Wednesday each week to allow for enhanced cleaning due to the increased number of people coming into each building. These numbers need to be limited at this time to ensure social distancing. The determining factors between two days or four days per week will be the number of students attending each building. Currently, the schools that require two days of in-person instruction per week are listed below.
