What to Expect in Kindergarten

Bible:

- Understand that God gave us the Bible as His only written word
- Learn major characters of the Old & New Testaments
- Memorize the books of the Old and New Testament
- Memorize and recite Psalm 100, Psalm 8, Luke 2:7-14 Psalm 97, Genesis 1:1-14
- Sing and pray daily
- Learn what sin is, what obedience is, God's love and forgiveness, His creative and sustaining power, His holiness and unchanging character
- Recite from memory the first 15 Westminster catechism questions
- Narrate and re-tell bible stories
- The Advent Jesse Tree Devotions

Reading (Phonics, Spelling, and Handwriting): Saxon K

- Learn upper and lower case letters of the alphabet
- Learn sounds of consonants and long and short vowel sounds
- Blend sounds to form short vowel words
- Phonemic awareness
- Coding tools marking common vowel patterns and letter clusters
- Identify most letter clusters
- Use end marks and capitals in a complete sentence
- Transcribe short sentences from Scripture and poetry

Math: Saxon 1

- Use manipulative techniques to count, sort, compare, organize, add subtract, make designs, etc.
- Learn to write numbers correctly
- Learn to arrange items to form predictable patterns
- Count forward and backward
- Learn to graph information
- Learn basic geometric shapes
- Count by 1's, 5's, 2's and 10's to 100
- Calendar skills
- Learn the values of a penny, nickel, dime, quarter, and dollar
- Learn the half-hour and hour markings on a clock
- Geoboards
- Tangrams
- Weight, capacity and measurement
- Beginning math facts
- Correctly organize items according to their distinctive properties & characteristics
- Make correct comparisons between items according to length, quantity, weight, volume & duration
- Explore & correctly use basic (1-20) addition & subtraction using manipulative tools
- Describe correctly fractions of 1/2
