# High School:

- Monitor your student's participation in their classes.
- Encourage your student to communicate with their teachers if they are struggling.
- Be aware of your student's progress.
- Seek out extra help from your student's teachers, counselor, or principal as needed.
- Encourage your student to problem-solve with their teacher if issues arise with their academics or technology.
- Take advantage of extra support offered by your school.
- Monitor your student's online activity.



# Special Education:

## How Can I Help My Child Be Successful During a Period of Remote Learning?

- Provide a space for your child to complete their schoolwork.
- Implement a daily schedule for learning at home.
- Know your child's online learning schedule, including IEP services that will be provided.
- Assist your child as you are able with assignments.
- Be aware of your child's academic progress.
- Communicate with your child's teacher or case manager if your child is struggling.
- Work as a team with your child's teacher, case manager, or principal to problem-solve any issues.
- Monitor your child's online activity.



# All Students:

## How Can I Help My Child Be Safe at School?

- Know and understand the new expectations and safety procedures that your school is implementing, including safety procedures on school transportation.
- Discuss these expectations and safety procedures with your child to ensure their understanding.
- Contact your child's teacher or principal with questions you have about the new safety procedures.
- Assure your child that school staff are working very hard to keep school a safe place to learn.
- Teach your child how to wear a mask (if they are able) and have them practice at home.
- Wash cloth masks each night and dispose of disposable masks at the end of each school day.
- Teach and reinforce good hand-washing practices (20 seconds, using soap and water).
- Check your child's temperature each morning before they come to school.
- Keep your child home if they are experiencing any symptoms of illness.
- Alert your school office immediately if your child becomes ill.
- Keep your child home until symptoms resolve or until they test negative for COVID-19.
- Work with your child's teacher to allow for your child to stay involved in completing their schoolwork remotely, if necessary.
- Be aware of your child's feelings and refer any mental health concerns your child may experience to your school's principal or counselor.
