CLASSROOM AND STUDENT SUPPORT

WHOLE SCHOOL FIELD TRIP TO OVERTURE CENTER

WFK sponsored a field trip for the entire school to attend a performance of Dino-Lights at the Overture Center for the Arts. The performance combined puppetry, dance, technology and science, and helped us achieve our goal for the year of funding more STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, & Math) activities for all students. We spent approximately \$4,000 to purchase tickets and bus transportation.

CLASSROOM SUPPORT

At the beginning of the school year WFK provided each teacher with a gift certificate to purchase any needed classroom supplies.

We spent \$975 on this.

HEALTH ROOM

WFK purchased \$130 worth of clothing items for the health room for students who need a change of clothes.



RIF BOOKS

WFK purchased books to be distributed as part of the Reading is Fundamental (RIF) program that provides each student with a new book twice during the school year. We spent \$1500 on this.



SAFETY PATROL

WFK spent \$200 to purchase gift cards for each of the students who had served in the 5th Grade Safety Patrol.



ART ROOM

We allocated the \$1500 raised through Art to Remember this past year for supplies and items for the Art Room

COMMUNITY CUPBOARD

When school closed due to COVID-19, WFK added snacks to the Little Free Library outside school. WFK has since relocated the books and snacks and has been stewarding a Community Cupboard with food, hygiene items and books. We spent approximately \$250 on this.

TEACHER CONFERENCE POTLUCKS


