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Overview

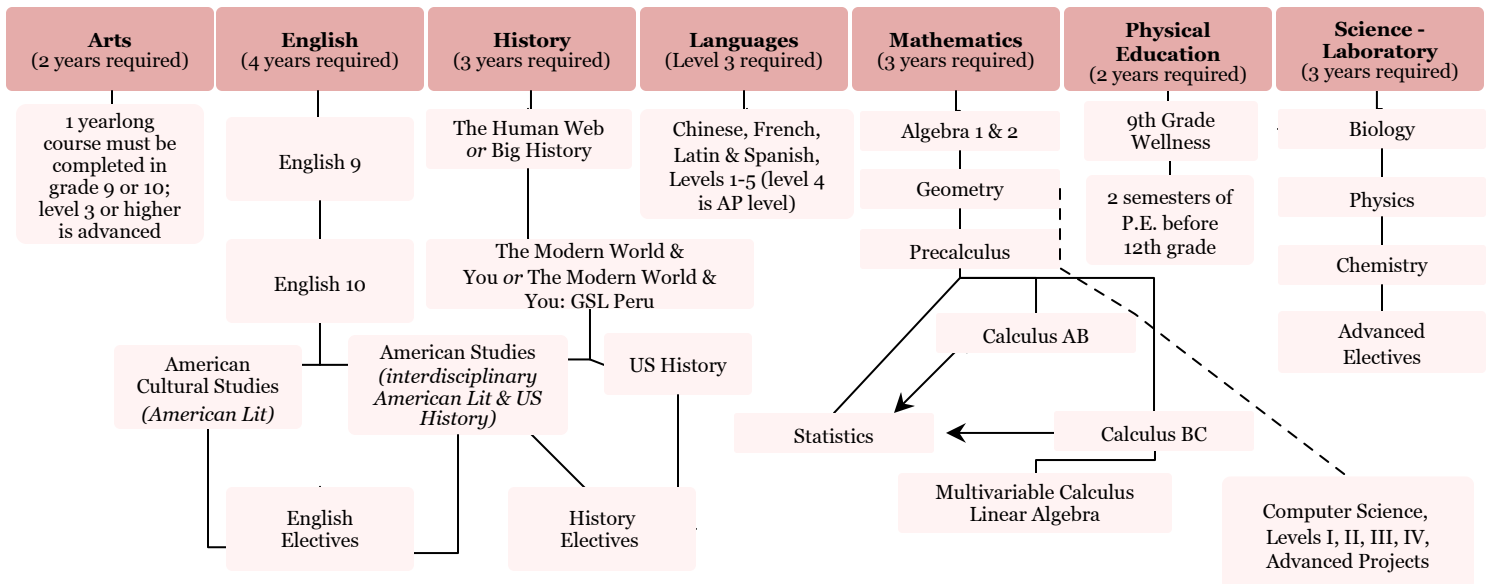
Founded in 1919, Lakeside School is a coeducational, independent, nonsectarian day-school serving students in grades 5-12. Robust academic and extracurricular programs offer students a deep foundation in the liberal arts through critical inquiry and writing, project-based learning, and experiential education. All students complete a one-week outdoor trip and engage in a minimum of 80 hours of service learning, which culminates in a capstone reflection project. More than half of students participate in a Global Service Learning experience for four weeks in an underdeveloped part of the world, living and working with local people - students engage in extensive curricular work before the trip and complete additional related service upon return. Through a Lakeside education, students become strong unstructured problem-solvers, communicators, and collaborators who engage learning and the world around them with an ethical, equitable, and inclusive mindset.

Academic Program

While AP courses are not offered, most classes meet or exceed the rigor of the AP curriculum. Only Arts, Math and Science use "Honors" or "Advanced" designations. Students can also take classes through Global Online Academy (GOA). Lakeside does not release a grade point average, rank students, or give awards or honors. Because Lakeside expects a high level of personal responsibility from its students, school policy is to report suspensions. Students sign a Statement of Community Expectations.





College Matriculation: 2016 - 2020

Typically 100% of graduates attend four-year colleges. Over the last five years, Lakeside alumni have enrolled at 132 colleges.
