Re: 20-21 Academic Calendar Adjustments

Due to current needs to provide more professional learning for staff, and to reduce the impact of scheduled half days on the elementary hybrid model, I am proposing the following adjustments to the 20-21 Academic Calendar:

- Move the currently scheduled June 1, 2021 Professional Learning Day to Monday, November 2, 2020. This would create a four-day weekend for students as Election Day, November 3, is currently scheduled as a Professional Learning Day. Having these two days back to back would provide time for staff to:
o Plan for the return of students to full-time school at some levels. Planning could include curricular and instructional adjustments as well as training in technology.
o Curriculum and instructional collaboration for levels not returning to full, inperson instruction.
o Building-based needs.
- Cancel the early release PD days scheduled for January 15 and February 23 and make those full days.
- Make the $1 / 2$ day Professional Learning scheduled for February 11 a full day before the long weekend.
- This last change would require another day to be added to the calendar. The projected last day of school would be June 17, 2020.

While we may not be in the hybrid model in winter, the possibility does exist. Removing these half days would ensure both AM and PM cohorts receive in-school instruction on January 15 and February 23.

I will answer any questions on this proposal at the October 13 Board of Education meeting.
