 BPAC	<p><u>Bilingual Parent Advisory Council (BPAC)</u> is a group for bilingual parents in the district. The BPAC meets a minimum of four times per year and discusses topics pertaining to bilingual education as well as gives parents an opportunity to provide feedback to the district on programming.</p>
 PTSA	<p><u>Parent Teacher Student Association (PTSA)</u> is an independent, non-profit, volunteer-run organization and part of the PTA umbrella that has supported our students throughout their tenure in Elmhurst District 205 schools. PTSA at York promotes the welfare of all York students and the York community.</p>
 PTSA-AC	<p><u>PTSA Academic Committee</u> is the academic advocacy committee of the York PTSA, spotlighting those York clubs and PTSA events/activities which are academically-oriented.</p>
 SERG	<p><u>Special Education Resource Group (SERG)</u> supports parents of District 205 children with special needs from ages 3 to 21 by connecting parents, educators and administrators to increase understanding and collaboration; sponsoring programs on topics related to special education; providing resources; and increasing awareness and support for individuals with disabilities in our community.</p>
 Athletic Boosters	<p><u>York Athletic Boosters</u> supports the York High School athletic program with sports equipment and materials that are above and beyond the norm supplied by District 205. Funds are raised by selling advertising, selling apparel, selling concessions at home football games, membership sales, and funds raised at the annual Green Scene.</p>
 Drama Boosters	<p><u>York Drama Boosters</u> are parents, friends and community members who support the York Drama Program by raising funds for departmental needs not covered by their budget or ticket sales such as production equipment, costumes, student scholarships and more.</p>
 Music Boosters	<p><u>York Music Boosters (YMB)</u> supports Performing Arts music students by funding grants and scholarships, administering student escrow accounts, managing formal uniform distribution and collection, providing volunteer ushers for concerts, hosting concert receptions, and providing additional funding and assistance as needed (i.e. Fine Arts Week, instrument purchases, guest musicians).</p>
