Admission Process Checklist

Links to required forms are available on the How To Apply page of the CSG website.

■ *Application Form*

Complete the online Application for Admission and submit with an application fee of \$50.

■ *Parent Meeting*

Call the Office of Admission to schedule a parent meeting with an admission director. We look forward to learning more about your daughter and helping you get to know CSG during this meeting. Meetings can be scheduled virtually via Zoom (30-45 min) or in person on campus (75 min).

After your initial parent meeting, you may also choose to meet virtually with a student ambassador. While these meetings are not required, we strongly encourage them, as they provide a valuable opportunity to share the student perspective.

■ *Parent Questionnaire*

Complete and submit the online parent questionnaire.

■ *Student Questionnaire*

Students complete and submit the online student questionnaire.

■ *Virtual Student Visit*

A student visit allows us to get to know your daughter one-on-one. Student visits are scheduled after a parent meeting is complete. This year students will drop in on classes via Zoom to get to know our teachers and their peer group. Additionally, students may have virtual one-on-one meetings with students and teachers.

■ *Testing*

Arrange to take the Independent School Entrance Exam (ISEE). Registration available at www.iseetest.org. The ISEE may be waived if a student has taken the PSAT, SSAT, SAT, or ACT within the past year.

■ *Teacher Recommendation*

Download and sign the English and Math recommendation forms. Give them to your daughter's current teachers after November 1 to ensure they have time to get to know her. Teachers should send the completed form directly to CSG.

■ *School Records*

Sign the Transcript Release form, and give to your daughter's school office. The school should send your daughter's records directly to the CSG Office of Admission. Be sure they include a copy of this year's most recent grading period.
