

Welsh School Dress Code - 2020/21

TOP

- No hoods may be worn during the school day.
- No students may wear hats, headbands, durags, sweatbands, bandannas, or head coverings during the school day.
- No students will be allowed to wear sleeveless shirts.
- No students will be allowed to wear tank tops, halter tops, tube tops, or midriffs. Students may not wear transparent tops without adequate undergarments. No tops cut low in the front, back or side will be allowed. There should be no skin showing between the bottom of the blouse and the top of pants or skirt when arms are extended above the head.
- Jackets must be worn over sundresses. Straps on dresses/tops should be no thinner than two inches - No "spaghetti straps". Off-the-shoulder tops or dresses are not allowed - NO bare shoulders.
- Extremely long shirts will not be allowed. Long shirts must be tucked in.
- No students may wear dark glasses while inside the school building.

BOTTOM

- Closed-toe shoes must be worn at all times. NO SANDALS or SLIDES.
- Pajamas, slippers / houseshoes, or other nightwear may NOT be worn to school.
- Students will be allowed to wear shorts, dresses, and skirts of modest length. All should be no shorter than three inches from the top of the knee.
- Sagging will not be allowed. Pants should be worn at waist level and loose pants must be worn with a belt

ALSO

- All students are expected to maintain the highest possible standards of personal hygiene. This includes personal cleanliness, as well as wearing clean clothing.
 - No students will be allowed to wear clothing or jewelry which displays suggestive slang, advertising (alcohol, drugs), or inappropriate language.
 - Students will not be allowed to wear torn, frayed, or cut clothing.
 - Except for piercing of the ears and wearing of earrings, wearing of other body piercing items/tattoos is not allowed by any student.
 - Wallet chains and/or oversized chains are not allowed at school or on school buses.
 - Proper undergarments must be worn with all clothing with no substitutes or exceptions.
- **Students not following the dress code are subject to disciplinary action and parents will be required to bring a change of clothes.**
