

Request for Remote Learning Form

In the event that you choose to have your child opt out of all in-person instruction due to COVID-19, but utilize Remote Learning resources please fill out this form (one for each student) and return it to your child's school.

With regard to Remote Learning, students, in a temporary situation, participate in their education remotely, and it is delivered by certified teachers utilizing an established curriculum. Although there is no substitution for in person learning, students will have access to assignments and curriculum via their teacher's Google Classroom and the Learning Hub provided by the State of CT. They will be graded and must participate in our full academic program. Students cannot distance themselves from learning on some days and come to school in-person on other days. Students who opt to participate in remote learning will not be allowed to participate in extracurricular activities. Please review the complete Remote Learning guidelines in the Region 14 Reopening letter.
