Dear Trinity Parents,

For six weeks, Trinity’s campus has been filled with expressions of joy, excitement, and gratitude. Many prayers, extraordinary preparations, and a persistent resolve on the part of our community have resulted in a great opening of the 2020-2021 school year. Thank you for the many ways you have encouraged and helped us. By God’s grace, we will continue to learn and teach and enjoy being together. We covet your prayers throughout the coming days, weeks, and months, even as we raise our Ebenezer and mark God’s blessings thus far.

Our classes, both on-campus and remote, are filled with a record enrollment of 750 students. Preparing for all these students has entailed much effort and cost. The Business, Admission, IT, and Registrar’s offices experienced a demanding summer like no other. Our Facilities Team worked seemingly non-stop to reconfigure classrooms, relocate furniture, find storage, and manage the installation of the Synexis DHP system and the new remote learning equipment for all our classrooms.

In addition to the herculean efforts of our staff, the purchase of hand sanitizer stations, touchless paper towel dispensers, rapid temperature scanners, disinfecting wipes, desk shields for all students in K-6 classrooms, remote learning enhancements that include 55” TV screens, microphone and document cameras for 42 classrooms, 72 new computer access points throughout our buildings, outfitting a new Health Annex, and the Synexis system to deliver dry hydrogen peroxide into all building spaces, has added COVID related expenses of more than \$400,000 to our annual fund-raising needs.

God’s faithful provision over our 33 years has allowed us to commit to these measures confidently and expectantly. The \$400,000 expense of COVID fighting measures, in addition to our Annual Fund needs of \$565,000, has increased the fund-raising goal for the 2020-2021 school year significantly.

We ask you to help us offset the cost of this year’s extraordinary measures through a gift to the Annual Fund marked “COVID expenses.” We are fully persuaded that investing in Trinity will pay lasting dividends both in time and eternity.
