International Academy West Senior Portraits Yearbook Specs

Congratulations on making it to your senior year at the International Academy! Here are some common questions & answers about senior pictures for yearbook use. Please read them carefully, as we do not wish anyone to be excluded from the senior section of the yearbook!

What are the yearbook and composite picture specifications?

Size: 2 1/4 " x 3" <u>COLOR</u> photo (no Black & White, Sepia, etc.)

Head: 1 ½" **Head**-Top: ½"

Finish: Glossy

Pose: Head-and-shoulder shot looking at the camera

(Very similar to passport photo requirements)

Background: Traditional, neutral (blue/gray), & solid background only

Other: Absolutely <u>no</u> hands to face in the pose, <u>no</u> fade or reflection effects,

<u>no</u> extreme close-ups, <u>no</u> "nature" shots, <u>no</u> pets, <u>no</u> chairs, <u>no</u> hats

*** New: <u>Digital copies</u> are accepted and encouraged for the yearbook and/or composite

photos

1) What is the due date for senior pictures?

The deadline for turning in your Senior Portrait for the yearbook is

Friday, October 29, 2021

2) What if I can't afford the sitting fee or the picture packages?

The International Academy West has provisions in place for this scenario. Contact the yearbook adviser, Ms. Webster at dwebster@bloomfield.org, directly for further information.

3) What if I decide to take my picture with my own camera?

Any self-taken portraits must follow the guidelines above and be cut down to the 2 ¼ "x 3" size. However, please be aware that we reserve the right to refuse any pictures that do not look professional or appropriate for the yearbook.

4) What will happen if I do not turn in a senior picture at all?

We may use your school ID picture! Therefore, if you have not had your senior picture taken by registration day, make sure that your ID picture looks nice (no t-shirts) in case we have to use it in the senior section.

5) When & where do I turn my senior picture in?

Turn them into the Yearbook Advisor, Ms. Webster, dwebster@bloomfield.org any time up until the <u>October 29, 2021</u> deadline
