Bell Schedule

- **Students with the last names starting with A-Lamb will attend in-person on Monday and Tuesday.**
- **Students with the last names starting with Lamc-Z will attend in-person on Wednesday and Thursday.**

Example of the week: Each week students with the last name of A-Lamb will attend in-person on Monday and Tuesdays. On Wednesday and Thursday these students will stay home and work independently on assignments in Canvas. Some teachers may ask students to WebEx into class when they are at home but understand that the learning will be some visual and mostly audio as the teachers will be focusing on the students in the classroom. WebEx during seminar on Wednesday and Thursday for attendance.

Arrival and Dismissal

- Multiple entrances will be open for students to enter and leave
- Upon arrival at school, students will go directly to their classroom
- Masks need to be worn once on SM East Campus. This means when students get out of their car, the mask must be on.
- Busses will drop off at the South Ramp doors instead of the North Ramp doors.

Classroom Expectations

- Students will sanitize their hands when they enter and exit the classroom.
- Teachers will communicate their classroom expectations.
- Students will be expected to follow each teacher's classroom expectations.
- Students should bring their own container for water and use touchless bottle filling stations. Food will not be allowed in classrooms.

Passing Periods

- Students will need to stay on the right side of the hallway.
- Students will go directly to their next class.
- Stairwells/ramps are one way.
- 3rd, 4th and 5th floor - center stairs are down only, end of hallway stairs are up only.
- North ramp is down only and South ramp will be up only.

Breakfast

- Food must be consumed in the cafeteria before leaving for class.

Lunch

- There will be four lunches instead of three lunches.
- You must enter the cafeteria from the North ramp.
- Individual desks have been set up for social distancing.
- Students will not share food.
- Food must be consumed in the cafeteria before leaving for class.
- Seniors will be allowed open lunch if documentation is completed.

Restrooms

- Teachers will develop a plan per each floor of the building for restroom use per class period.

Physical Education Classes

- Students will need to come on PE days dressed and ready for class.
- Lockers will not be checked out at this time.
