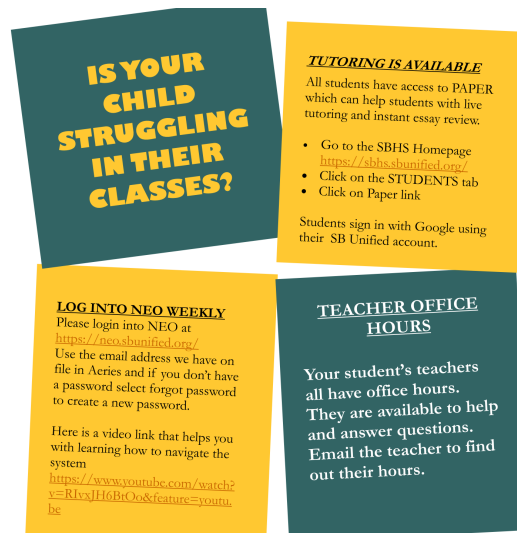

## Academic Support and Term 1 Grades



Please check out how your child is doing in their classes by viewing their NEO classes on a weekly basis. Encourage your child to complete their work and ask for help. You will be able to see their Term 1 grades in Aeries on Oct. 21st. **These grades will also go onto the transcript as the final grade for the term.** Grades DO matter. Earning a failing grade means that your child did not earn credit towards graduation. If your child earned a passing grade of a “D,” they may not be on track towards being UC/CSU “a-g” eligible. Please email your child’s counselor and teacher to discuss next steps. It is important to address the reasons for the low grades now. Please email your child’s teachers and/or counselor if you have any questions.

### *Update on Community Service*

In response to input from the community, we will accept and record community service hours completed since school closure in March. We reiterate that the requirement to fulfill community service hours is suspended in response to the conditions associated with COVID in order to protect the safety of students and community members.
