



# COVID-19 RESPONSE

October 19, 2020

The School is informed about a positive COVID-19 case in our community

**DIRECT EXPOSURE TO SOMEONE WITH COVID-19**

- Living with or caring for a positive person
- Being within 6 feet of a positive person for 15+ minutes
- Being coughed/sneezed on, sharing a drink/utensils, kissing, etc.

School pulls seating charts and nurses contact everyone who may have been directly exposed.

Timeframe: Within hours, taking up to 48-72 hours to complete

School collaborates with the health department to determine likely exposure. Health department conducts contact tracing and may speak to potentially exposed individuals.

Timeframe: 10+ days

Potentially exposed students/employees will be asked to remain home for 48-72 hours (and plan for 14 days) while the health department determines likely exposure

School shares pertinent info with greater community when we have enough information to do so.

Timeframe: Varies, but as soon as possible

**NOTE:** For confidentiality, School will not share names, situations, or grade levels.

**\*NEW\*** Siblings, parents, and other household members will NOT be asked to stay home so long as no one in the household is showing COVID-19 symptoms.

After quarantine, in collaboration with the health department, School clears potentially exposed students and employees to return to School.

Timeframe: 48-72 hours initially, lasting up to 14 days

Families/employees will be required to complete a clearance form to return to School
