Due to the current virus protocol we will maintain social distancing and mandatory facial coverings at all our gymnasiums for basketball games, wrestling matches, middle school volleyball and swim events this year. We will cap attendance at 25% of the gymnasium capacity. Please find the following capacities:

There shall be no spectator attendance when the county is classified as Orange Two. When we host a game or match in these gym's we will only sell the number of tickets listed in the Virus Capacity. Visitor tickets must be sent to the visiting school for pre-sale only for both adults and students. Other than the teams, table workers, media, security, no one will be allowed to be on the gym floor. Media should be provided a location opposite the score table. Radio or TV play by play may be allowed on the sideline.

Distribution of tickets:

1. Players parents or guardians (2-4)
2. Home students
3. Visitors
4. Pre-sale tickets will be available

Entering Facility

1. Ticket sellers and takers will be masked with gloves-Acrylic cover at ticket booth

2. Six feet distancing while in line to enter
3. All persons entering facility ages 10 years old and older will be required to wear a mask
4. Masks are to remain on at all times while in the facility (remove only to eat or drink)

#### Concessions

1. All food will be pre-packaged
2. Workers will be masked with gloves
3. Concession stand lines will be 6 feet distancing

#### Seating:

1. Every other row will be vacant
2. Seating will be separated by 6 feet intervals
3. No standing room will be allowed
4. Family groups will be allowed to sit together

#### On the floor

1. Only table workers will be allowed on the same side as the teams seating area.
2. Media (print, radio or TV) shall be seated on the opposite side of scores table and teams
3. Spirit squads will maintain social distancing in the end zone opposite ends of the court. Each participant shall be spaced 6 feet from the next person (Maximum squad size is 10).
4. All on floor halftime performances must be approved by site Administration and conform to social distancing while performing.
5. Coaches, trainers, table workers, officials, site administration and media will wear masks at all times.
6. The officials will be given 5 cleaned basketballs for the boys and 5 cleaned basketballs for the girls. The balls will be cleaned during stoppage of play during the contest.
7. Hand sanitizer will be available on the benches and at the scores table.
8. Players and coaches will provide their own personal beverages.
9. Teams will be asked to come to the facility dressed and plan on minimal use of locker rooms.
10. All hospitality areas must only have pre-packaged food and drink.
11. When each game is completed those student athletes should leave the building.
12. There shall be no post-game mingling of opposing teams, No high fives etc.

Be sure and check the pre-game procedure in the game management booklet and not allow anyone in the gymnasium who is not wearing a mask.
