To schedule a visit, please visit: www.SCOIR.com . Your visit request is pending until confirmed in SCOIR. Visit requests are processed on a first come, first served basis due to space availability.

University Prep's daily schedule is a rotating block plan of six academic class periods spread out over three days. We are maintaining this schedule, in a virtual format, as we begin the 2020-2021 school year. In a typical academic year, we offer set visit times each day for 30-35 minute sessions and during particularly busy times, we will add additional visit times as needed.

For the fall of 2020, University Prep will be offering virtual college representative visits. UPrep can host the visits using Zoom; however, if colleges have a meeting platform they prefer, we'd encourage representatives to be the "host." Due to UPrep's online class schedule, we will have limited visit availability this fall. We are offering three thirty-minute time slots each day; one before school (7:45 – 8:15 a.m.) and two after school (2:45 – 3:15 and 3:15 – 3:45 p.m.). To schedule a visit, please log into SCOIR.
