Valedictorian/Salutatorian Selection Process East High School 2019

The selection process for East High School begins the first week of May. Selection for Valedictorian and Salutatorian begins with GPA, but includes the rigor of the transcript. Criteria begins with the cumulative GPA of the student; point values are assigned for GPA and AP/Concurrent Courses.

East High School Point System

1. Cumulative GPA will be determined at the end of 3rd Term of the senior year. The top ten seniors will be first ranked by GPA and given a point value of:

1st	30 pts.	6th	15 pts.
2nd	27 pts.	7th	12 pts.
3rd	24 pts	8th	9 pts.
4th	21 pts.	9th	6 pts.
5th	18 pts	10th	3 pts.

2. The number of Advance Placement/Concurrent classes taken from freshman to senior year. The following point value will be awarded:

1st	10 pts.	6th	5 pts.
2nd	9 pts.	7th	4 pts.
3rd	8 pts	8th	3 pts.
4th	7 pts.	9th	2 pts.
5th	6 pts	10th	1 pts.

In the event that two or more student have the same GPA and Advance Placemen/Concurrent. Student(s) will receive the same point values but the ranking placements of 1 to 10 remain the same. The ranking for the next student will continue as follows:

Mary 4.0-30 pts Jack 4.0- 30 pts Maria 3.9- 24 pts (ranked 3rd) Jo 3.8 – 21 pts (ranked 4th)

The student doesn't receive a higher ranking due to the tie.

- 3. Point values will be added to determine Valedictorian and Salutatorian. The Principal will then notify the top two students.
 - ** Candidates must attend at least 2 semesters during their junior and senior year.
