Directive from the Monmouth County Health Department

The County has been receiving an increase in school districts concerned about individuals who are under quarantine or isolation who do not follow the directions to stay home. It is important for everyone to understand that individuals under quarantine or isolation are mandated to do so by law. Quarantine and isolation are not an option.

While quarantines and isolations are not usually convenient, this is one of the most effective methods we have right now absent a vaccine and real antiviral treatments to limit community spread of COVID19.

Superintendents are expected to contact their local health officer when they learn that members of their school community are violating quarantine or isolation so that the appropriate action can be taken by the County Department of Health.
