**FLU SEASON** – Influenza activity typically begins in October and peaks between December and February, according to the CDC. Each year it causes millions of illnesses in the U.S. and those aged 65 and older account for the majority of flu hospitalizations and deaths. An annual flu vaccine is the best way to reduce your risk of getting sick. This year is especially important since flu symptoms are similar to those of COVID-19. Getting the flu vaccine this season will reduce symptoms that may be confused with COVID-19 and limit the number of illnesses, hospitalizations, and ICU admissions, alleviating stress on the health care system. Make an appointment to get vaccinated in your physician's office, or at one of the many pharmacies offering the shots. Continue to wear a mask, wash your hands often, and practice social distancing.
