Grand Opening: Gym and Performing Arts Center



What exciting things spring is bringing to Countryside! In addition to the glorious weather, our new Gymnasium and Performing Arts Center addition is getting closer to completion every day. We are close, but we are not quite there yet! To date we have raised \$2.2 million on a \$3 million fundraising goal.

To help our school finish this important addition for our children, I am pleased to announce that an anonymous donor has pledged to make a \$50,000 matching donation to our new Gym and Performing Arts Center. What this means is that every new dollar that is pledged to support our new facility will be matched by the anonymous donor on a one-to-one basis up to \$50,000! In other words, a new gift of \$1,000 from one of our families or friends would actually be worth \$2,000 through this generous match!

The purpose of this match is to encourage each Countryside family and all donors to participate in the building of our new facility at the highest level possible. Regardless of amount, every gift is important and each new gift will be doubled.

In addition, we are delighted to announce that we are offering granite "brick" pavers for sale to anyone who would like to have a permanent, highly visible tribute outside of the front entrance of the new facility. The brick pavers may be engraved with your family name, children's names or in honor of a beloved teacher, friend, or family member. The choice is yours.

For every commitment of \$1,000 or more, not only will your gift be matched on a dollar for dollar basis by our anonymous donor, but you will also receive one brick paver to engrave. For donations less than \$1,000, your donation will still be matched, but you will not receive a brick.

We need to receive all brick orders no later than June 15 in order to have them ready for installation prior to our August 26 grand opening. If you would like a brick order form, contact Jamie Driver, Development Director at Jamie.driver@att.net.

Please mark your calendars for **Sunday**, **August 26 at 3 p.m.** when we will have the **Grand Opening** of our new Gym and Performing Arts Center, including the Cathie Webber Stage! Great News from the Past Year

We watched the construction of our new Gym and Performing Arts Center opening in August!

Our choruses, band, and ensemble groups performed their two concerts at Faith United Methodist Church with a DVD produced of the winter concert.

The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Poster, Poetry and Prose Contest honored fifth graders Dante and Mary Ann and fourth graders Ethan and Sophia.

Sixth grader Anshul was named Warren Junior Chess Scholar again - an award given to only 25 K-8th grade chess players in Illinois. In addition he won the state championship for his grade for the fourth year in a row at the Illinois State All Grade Chess Championship.

Countryside welcomed new teachers: third grade teacher Marci Warren, fifth grade teacher Maya Enriques, Chinese teacher Hsiao-Ching Chen, Latin teacher Patrick Neff and PE/Athletic Director Chad Simpson.

The Champaign-Urbana Optimist Club honored fifth graders with Challenge Awards: Alex in Science and Mary Ann in Arts.

Eighth grader Taylor and alum Ben Chapman danced the roles of Clara and the Nutcracker Prince in *The Nutcracker* at Krannert Center for the Performing Arts with the CU Ballet. Seven other Countryside students performed in the production!

Our MathCounts team took 3rd place in regional competition and reached Gold Level Status as a MathCounts club. Sixth grader Anshul took 3rd in individual competition and 2nd in the Countdown Round.

Our Odyssey of the Mind team placed 1st at State and advances to World competition at the end of May. This is the seventh consecutive year we have competed at Worlds!

Third grader Colette placed 7th in the state in Level 4 gymnastics on balance beam.

Sixth grader James competed in the National Trumpet Competition held in Washington, DC. He also earned a scholarship to Interlochen Summer Arts Camp.

Our all-school world service project benefitted *help2read* – providing books to establish libraries in South Africa. We raised over \$1,100 – enough to provide 2,278 new books!

The All-School Music Show, Camp Countryside, included songs and dances about summer camp!

Service projects benefitted *learn2read*, Eastern Illinois Foodbank, Anita Purves Nature Center, Times Center, Windsor of Savoy, Clark-Lindsey Village, an orphanage in Guadalajara, Mexico, and Countryside School.

Sixth grader Grace competed in the ISI Winter Classic National ice skating competition winning 2nd place in Solo Character Spotlight, 3rd place in Freestyle 3, and 3rd place in Interpretive FS3.

Sixth graders Katie, Grace Q, and Delaney, 8th grader Omri, and alumna Natalie will appear in Champaign Urbana Theatre Company's "Thoroughly Modern Millie" this summer.

Third grader Ethan placed 2nd in the state and 5th in the nation in the Math Kangaroo contest!


