


ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

ISB cares about students' growth as learners and as individuals who contribute to their community. The school believes that young people are naturally curious and recognizes each student as a unique individual with the potential to achieve. Students are empowered to solve problems, question the world around them, and develop and test hypotheses in a collaborative, supportive environment.







DUAL LANGUAGE PROGRAM

ISB gives Early Years 3 to Grade 3 families the option to enroll in its Dual Language Program. This program offers students the opportunity to become bilingual, bi-literate, and bi-cultural, in that students learn for 50 percent of their day in Chinese and 50 percent in English. Learning in two languages allows students to develop respect and appreciation towards language, culture, and global diversity.



MIDDLE SCHOOL Explore

Middle School is a time for exploration and personal development as well as forming healthy academic habits. ISB believes in nurturing students to be well-rounded community members. Through collaborative study and service learning projects, students are given the opportunity to experiment and tailor their own personal development. All students have the opportunity to be part of a sports team or perform in an arts group, and to show leadership through clubs and activities.







Near the beginning of the academic year, our Middle School students venture off campus to explore China and get to know their peer group. These learning experiences are designed for team building; they help students to form strong relationships, build resilience, and learn how to work well with one another. Our Mentoring classes provide an important setting for developing healthy relationships and a sense of identity aligned with ISB's Core Values.





In the High School, our role is to nurture the talents of our students and develop their skills through authentic learning experiences that ensure they are engaged members of society. ISB's approach places value on the student's health and character development along with their academic performance.







Outcomes matter at ISB and the school believes successful students are not defined solely by their attainment in tests and exams, but also by their integrity, empathy, and sense of teamwork. ISB offers a tailored education to prepare young people for achievement and success whatever future direction they choose.



NEW FACILITIES

ISB first relocated from its original U.S. Embassy location to the Lido campus in 1988 and moved to its current location – a 33-acre, purpose-built facility in Shunyi District – in 2002. Since then, we completed construction of a state-ofthe-art sports facility in 2013 and most recently opened all four of our brand-new facilities in 2020. These include an Elementary School Arts Center and Theater, a Middle School/High School Performing Arts Center, a Middle School/ High School Design Center, and our new Early Years Learning Community.
