- I. Minutes from the September meeting emailed. A motion was made by Susan Pembelton to approve the minutes. This motion was seconded by Justin Hicks and approved by all.
- II. II. President's Report-Teri Harris:
  - a. Falcon Five Grand tickets- \$100 each, all virtual this year. Each purchased ticket receives a "party in a bag" and a chance to win \$250 \$5000.
  - b. Welcome new faces! We are glad you are here!
- III. Head of School Report- Chance Reynolds.
  - a. Covid-19- we are doing well! There has been an uptick in our community, but everyday is a blessing and we are thankful to be here on campus. Staff, students, and parents are all doing an amazing job and it is such a team effort to remain on campus.
  - b. Intramural sports- two more days have been added to the schedule
  - c. Spring and winter sports are still in the planning stages.
  - d. Enrollment- in the past month, we have gained five students. Three more students begin school tomorrow, 10/20/20. Yay!
  - e. Campus Improvements- Holman Masonry completed the retainer wall for the volleyball court. Arbor Pro completed the tree work around the complex. The next step is digging drainage ditches. Stay tuned!
  - f. US gym restrooms- 80% of the goal has been raised. We have currently secured \$20,000 of the \$25,000 needed.

Thank you to the Eason family (Vivian and Caleb Eason) for running the concession stand at Fright Fest and helping to raise money for Fuqua! A special thank you to the Thompson family (Isabella Thompson) for also helping!
  - h. Falcon Five Grand-November 21, 2020. Ticket sales are going well! This is such an important fundraiser for our school. Sponsor letters have been sent. Since we

- cannot meet in person for the Falcon Five Grand, individuals have volunteered to have "mini house parties" (following all Covid related protocols). If you are interested in hosting a "house party", please contact Tammy Frank.
- i. Falcon Nest expense- Teri Harris' brother installed new bathroom lights and front porch lights for us. The bill was \$395.00 for the supply cost. Susan Pembelton made a motion to pay for the entire bill. Amy Rostan seconded the motion. This motion was approved by all.

  - a. Current balance: \$10,602
  - b. We ended the 2019-2002 school year with \$8415.00. We started the 2020-2021 year with this balance. So far this year we have profited \$8,872 (mum and mask fundraiser as well as a small amount from the clothing store)

    - iii. Social Services PK inspection was last week. It went well and we passed with flying colors!
    - iv. Spirit shirt designs were sent to Judy Ellington. Hoping to fill the school store again soon!
    - v. Scholastic book fair-October 26-30 at the LS.
  - b. b. Upper School- Jennings Custis.
    - i. Thank you to the PTSA for purchasing the dishwasher! Mr. Boswell's Biology class is very appreciative!
    - ii. We have had busy weeks in the US. Report cards went live today. The fall awards program was the Friday before fall break and was well received.
    - iii. SAT test- was hosted during the school day. 24 students took the SAT. The plan is to hold a testing session again in the spring.
    - iv. Battle of the Brains was held virtually this past Saturday.
    - v. Veterans Day program- this will not be held at Crute Stage. It will be held on the Fuqua football field. The band will put this program on.
    - vi. US art students- they are busy working on their pet project fundraiser!
    - vii. The art students have painted artwork on the Gallery Wall which looks like you are walking down the halls of a museum. It is awesome!

- a. Appreciation Committee-Tamara Wright, Susan Pembelton

    - b. The mum sales were an amazing fundraiser! We raised over \$4,000!
    - c. These two fundraisers helped us raise the same amount of money we would have raised during football and volleyball concessions.
  - b. Suzanne Davis: Original Works

a. 146 pieces of art work have been completed in grades PK-6. Thank you Tammy Frank and Chelsey Green! All the work has been wrapped and shipped to New York for processing. The art work will be scanned and orders can be completed through the online gallery. Individual, customized brochures will be sent home with each child showing families how to access the child's artwork and how to order products. These are estimated to be received on campus on November 4 and then parents have two weeks to order. Order deadline is November 18. Products will arrive roughly three weeks later in time for the holidays.
