The Homily was offered by Father Koh, with the help of four students, all of whom shared their experience with the unique Chapels we have held this year. As many of you know, this year's Chapel services have been expanded to include the celebration of other faiths and cultures. Chapel visitors and messages have included homilies provided by Jewish leaders for Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur; a blessing and celebration of Latin X heritage month (?) and Indigenous People's Day.

St. James' students shared their experience with these different messages and how they have valued learning about others. The students offered their conclusion about all of the messages which is that we are all children of God, and in whatever we way we observe God, he listens. It is as Mr. Reinke always reminds us, that when we put our hands together in prayer, God listens. And God is always ready and willing to listen to us when we call upon him. The message of similarity, that our students found in the different expressions of faith, is one of unity and community. When we come together and share our differences, we find common ground and similarities.
