lunch in Whitney Commons.



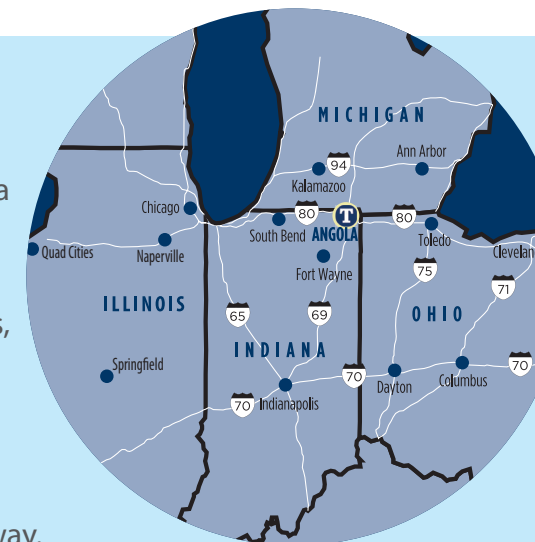
