



WHAT IS TITLE I?

► Title I is a K-12 program that provides additional academic support and learning opportunities for children at schools with high percentages of students who are economically disadvantaged. The program helps to ensure that all students have the resources to succeed and meet state academic standards. Title I funds are allocated by the federal government to the state and states allocate the funds to districts.



Title I seeks to increase academic achievement by:

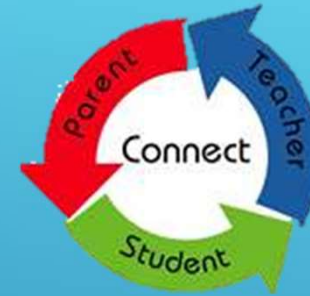
Providing direct instructional support to students
