

Before/After School Programs

LOWER SCHOOL: ADVENTURE KIDS

BEFORE-SCHOOL CARE

Before-school care is offered each weekday morning free of charge to all Lower School students. Every morning the Adventure Kids Program (AKP) program runs from 7 a.m. to the start of school; on Wednesdays, when classes begin at 8:45 a.m., students may attend AKP from 7 to 8:30 a.m. Before-school care is supervised by staff members who are committed to providing a fun, caring, and safe setting for students.

AFTER-SCHOOL PROGRAM

The after-school AKP program is held each school day from the end of classes until 6 p.m. and is staffed by the same caring, skilled staff as the before-school care program. Less structured than the regular school day, the after-school AKP program offers a variety of mixedage group activities, snack time, and quiet time for independent reading, games, and homework. Outdoor play is encouraged for all children throughout the seasons, including sledding and ice skating on the school's playground ice rink. There is a fee for the Lower School after-school AKP program; please inquire about rates.

FULL-DAY ACTIVITY PROGRAM

On many days when Lower School classes are not in session, such as Parent Conference or Faculty Professional Days, SPA offers fee-based, full-day care open to all Lower School students. The full-day program features field trips, outdoor play, craft projects, and other activities. The program is not in session on holidays or during school vacations.

MIDDLE SCHOOL

BEFORE-SCHOOL CARE

Middle School students may be dropped off as early as 7:30 a.m. to socialize or spend quiet time in common areas. On Wednesday mornings, a more formal, supervised morning program is offered free of charge to all Middle School students and is available between 7:30-8:30 a.m.

AFTER-SCHOOL PROGRAM

The supervised After-School Program (ASP) for Middle School students is held each school day from the end of classes until 6 p.m. This supervised program provides the space for students to complete homework, participate in outdoor activities, have a snack, and participate in various planned activities/projects. There is a fee for the Middle School ASP; please inquire about rates.

The Middle School also offers after-school and cocurricular activities, including interscholastic athletic teams, three annual theatrical productions, Lego League, and the Math Team. Meeting times for these activities generally run from 3:15 to 4:30 p.m. Middle School students who are enrolled in an afternoon extracurricular activity may opt for part-time ASP enrollment. When athletics are released early or practices are canceled due to weather, students may attend the ASP free of charge until 4:45 p.m.
