It is with a heavy heart that I write this message. After a long battle with cancer, Kate Boynton passed away yesterday. Mrs. Boynton was a beloved teacher at Wylie Elementary, a cherished colleague, a parent of three DCS students, and truly a great person. Kate Boynton was known throughout the district and community as a wonderful, caring, and inspiring colleague, neighbor, and friend. For over 20 years, Mrs. Boynton taught hundreds of DCS students to be readers, writers, thinkers, and caring people. We are all better educators and people having watched Mrs. Boynton work with kids and colleagues. She will be greatly missed.

We know that Mrs. Boynton was beloved by many in our district and community. Team Rainbow has been supporting Mrs. Boynton throughout her battle and many others are interested in how to support her family at this time. Further details will be shared once available.

Our district crisis team met this morning and are working to support our colleagues and students.
