Only students get out of their car. • Only staff and students can enter campus. No visitors or volunteers are allowed until further notice. • All students who arrive earlier than 8:10 AM, will be required to wait in their car/or outside of the school gates until 8:10 AM • KES Principal, AP, Security Personnel, and Parent Liaison will welcome students as they exit their car from the car line and direct them to their line. • Kindergarten students will be directed to the Kindergarten gates for both AM/PM • 1st – 8th Grade Students will enter through either the Admin/Library or South Entry Gates (Blackstone Ave.), and be directed to their 	<p>Materials in Class</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Your child’s teacher(s) will provide a recommended list of classroom supplies. Lunch times are TBD based on negotiations.</p> <p>Exits/Dismissal Procedures</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Teacher will walk their class to the designated pickup area. • Parents will pick up students in the car line. • Students will be placed in rows by class to wait for their car. • Kindergarten students will exit KES campus via the Kinder Exit Gate (see map) • Teachers will walk 1st – 3rd Grade students through the Admin/Library Gate to the KES driveline. • 4th – 8th Grade students may exit KES via either the Admin/Library Gate (at the driveline), or via the South Gate (on Blackstone Ave.) to walk home. • If a family has multiple children, they will need to be picked up at their designated area to ensure

- If families have multiple children, please drop off all your children at the area assigned to your youngest child.
- All students will go directly to their line up queue as they arrive and meet their teacher for temperature checks.
- _____ will take the temperature of each student as they wait in their outside queue, and assess for any symptoms indicating the child is ill:
 - 100.4 or higher is considered a fever and child will be sent to the office.
 - If child has a temperature of below 100.4 and indicates other symptoms of being sick, will also be sent to the office.
 - Students will be required to remain in either the KES nurse station, and/or COVID symptoms room while parents are contacted.
- Please do not send children to school if they are not feeling well.

- All rooms have disinfectant and spray hand sanitizer. Students will wash their hands or use hand sanitizer each time they enter and exit their classroom. You may also send a small hand sanitizer to school with your child.
- Our KES Custodial Staff will clean and disinfect classrooms daily. In addition, custodians will provide a more thorough cleaning twice each week.

Restrooms/Water Fountains

- Restrooms are disinfected and cleaned regularly throughout the day.
- Restrooms are set up to respect social distancing and only two students allowed inside at one time.
- Drinking fountains are not available.
- Please send your child with a water bottle.

One directional Facing/Seating

- Students will sit all in one direction facing the front of the class.
- All classrooms have student desks facing forward. Desks will be spaced apart to ensure social distancing.
- Room S-1 and S-2 (7th – 8th Science Labs) have front facing tables. Students will seat two per table to ensure social distancing.
- Students can bring their backpack.
