

NUTRITION SERVICES A LA CARTE SALES PROGRAM GUIDELINES

- All snack sales must meet nutritional standards per USDA/CDE Smart Snack Regulations
- Nutrition Services will only sell during lunch periods
- Students will receive a reimbursable meal before buying a Smart Snack food item
- No School Site Administrator will limit, cancel, or punish students with no A la Carte food sales due to students' behavior problems during the school day
- All students must be allowed to purchase at least two (2) items per sales transaction
- Smart Snack-compliant Ice Cream and Slush sales will be sold during lunches by Nutritional Services ONLY
- Fundraising by school sites with Smart Snack compliant food sales during any school lunch periods, other than the last Friday of the month, is strictly prohibited
- The last Friday of every month, school sites will be allowed to fund raise with Smart Snack compliant foods
- Smart Snack Food rules are suspended beginning 30 minutes after the last school bell
- The "School Day" (per USDA/CDE Regulations) is defined as Twelve(12) Mid-Night to Thirty (30) minutes after the last school bell
