

Dear Families:

It's difficult to believe that the last week of October is here! Halloween is just around the corner! Students are allowed to wear costumes next Friday, Oct. 30<sup>th</sup> in celebration of Halloween. Guidelines for costumes are listed below.

This last week we welcomed our latest group of students to campus. Joining us were some of our 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, and 11<sup>th</sup> graders. We are so happy to see familiar faces on campus again! As you will see below, the survey for Quarter 2 learning options is currently open and will close on Sunday, Oct. 25<sup>th</sup> at 11:59p.m. In this survey you may choose whether to keep your student at home for virtual learning, or to send them to school for on-campus learning for Quarter 2 (Nov. 4-Jan. 14). The change will begin on Wednesday, Nov. 4<sup>th</sup> and last through Thursday, Jan. 14, 2021. If you choose to send your student to campus, you can always switch back to virtual learning, you just can't switch them to on-campus learning outside of the survey window each 9 weeks, or Quarter. **You do not have to complete this survey if you are not making any changes.**

**Halloween Costume Guidelines for Friday, 10/30**

Costumes must meet these guidelines:

- Costumes that are provocative, revealing, or inappropriate are not permitted.
- All costumes must meet dress code requirements
- Costumes that depict violence, alcohol, or drugs are not permitted. Fake weapons are not allowed.
- Costumes that could be offensive or perpetuate a stereotype of someone’s culture, gender, heritage, or religion are not permitted.
