Steps to Become a Promise Student

'In an effort to stop the spread of <u>COVID-19</u>, we changed the delivery to our Promise Steps.

1. Apply to Allan Hancock College

Select summer if you will begin in the summer (June). Select fall if you will begin in fall (August).

YOU WILL NEED THE FOLLOWING TO APPLY:

Your high school transcript with an accurate GPA (if you've graduated within the last 10 years)

- A chosen major (what <u>degree or certificate</u> do you want to work toward?)
- A personal email address (you receive a student email account after registering for a class)
- Your Social Security Number (SSN) if you have one (more information below)

After you have submitted the application above, you will receive a welcome email to your personal email address that will help you get started with using your <u>myHancock portal</u>.
