OLD SAINTS' SCHOLARSHIP 2022

Applications close: **Friday, 26 February 2021 – 5.00pm**

As part of our commitment to remaining connected to our past, the College works with a wide-range of stakeholders, including the Old Saints, to develop and optimise opportunities for our former students and their families.

The Old Saints' Scholarship is offered on behalf of the alumni of All Saints' College and may be awarded to a child of former students (Old Saints) entering Year 7 in 2022. The recipient of this scholarship will be recognised as having sound academic results and strong community values.

Further, the recipient might be a young person who would otherwise not be able to join this community due to financial constraints. The value of the Old Saints' Scholarship is usually 50% of the College's academic tuition fee (please note that additional costs such as camps, uniform, textbooks, ICT charge, OLP charge, year level charges and other incidental costs may apply on an annual basis and these costs do not form part of the scholarship award).

LODGMET OF APPLICATION

Applications may be submitted online, by mail or in person to All Saints' College, although we encourage online applications wherever possible.

An application fee of \$50.00 is payable on submission.

Applicants are asked to supply the following:

- Completion of the Application Form-
- Two written personal references that speak to the student's experience in community service, leadership skills and commitment qualities in other areas such as sports, club involvements etc
- Copy of the student's two most recent academic reports
- Copy of the student's most recent NAPLAN results
- Copy of the student's birth certificate

Applications will be confirmed in writing by the Registrar within 10 working days of receipt.

SCHOLARSHIP INTERVIEW

Shortlisted candidates will be invited to an interview with the Principal and representatives from our Leadership Team.

NOTIFICATION OF SCHOLARSHIP OFFERS

All applicants will be notified regarding the outcome of the scholarship interview by the end of Term 2 2021.

Successful applicants will have ten working days in which to accept or decline a scholarship offer. This is confirmed by the return of the signed scholarship acceptance letter.

Old Saints' Scholarships are granted with the expectation that the student will maintain a committed approach to their educational pursuits and endeavours. Should this not be the case, the College reserves the right to withdraw the scholarship.

Recipients of the scholarship will be expected to join the Old Saints' Committee for one year, upon graduating from the College.
