About JIS

Jakarta International School is an independent, co-educational institution offering university preparation primarily for expatriate students. JIS is accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC) and is a member of the National Association of Independent Schools (NAIS) as well as the East Asia Regional Council of Schools (EARCOS).

Instruction is in English and all students earn a U.S. High School Diploma. Students may elect to enroll in the International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma during grades 11 and 12 or enroll in individual IB and / or Advanced Placement (AP®) courses.

The calendar covers 36 weeks over two academic semesters, August to December and January to June. Students attend four 85-minute class periods per school day.

Students

Of the 903 high school students, about 20% are from the United States, 20% from South Korea. 20% from Indonesia, and the remaining 40% are from more than 45 nations, including India, Canada, Australia, the Philippines and the United Kingdom.

Faculty

The faculty includes 100 members from 17 countries: 57 hold master's degrees, 3 have doctorates.


