Dear Wolves,

Eastlake continues to work on striking the right balance between academic progress and student wellness. We have developed a more coordinated, systemic plan to intervene with students not on track to graduate or currently failing a class. On Wednesday, we had teams of teachers reassess both student workload and expectations. We also reminded them of effective secondary grading practices.

We understand that students have seven classes and that everything takes longer in this remote setting. We understand that some students are struggling with other issues that interfere with success. We know that it is not only difficult to teach in this situation, but harder for students to learn as well.

Here is what we are working towards.

- Clear, consistent practices about what is due when and where.
- Consistent due dates, being mindful of assignment given on Monday/Tuesday versus Thursday/Friday because Wednesday is an asynchronous work day for students.
- Being available to meet with students during Wolf Time. Teachers can also be available to meet with students during Asynchronous Learning and Support, but those meetings need to be prearranged.
- Read and respond to emails within 48 hours and update grades every two weeks by the designated dates.

## Equity at Eastlake

In honor of Filipino Heritage Month, we celebrate Jose Antonio Vargas, a Filipino journalist, filmmaker, author and immigration rights activist. Vargas first publicly revealed his experience as an undocumented immigrant in a powerful essay for the New York Times Magazine in 2011. From there, he has continued to share his story and those of other undocumented immigrants through film and print. He advocates on behalf of undocumented immigrants through his non-profit organization [Define American](#), which works to humanize immigrants through representation in the media, and as part of the board for [TheDream.US](#), which provides scholarships for our DREAMers. Our 11th graders will have the opportunity to read Vargas' memoir entitled, Dear America: Notes of an Undocumented Citizen, which is "about homelessness, not in a traditional sense, but in the unsettled, unmoored psychological state that undocumented immigrants like myself find ourselves in... This book is about what it means to not have a home." ([Jose Vargas](#)) If you believe immigrant rights are human rights go to Densho and/or La Resistencia to support the work of local groups.



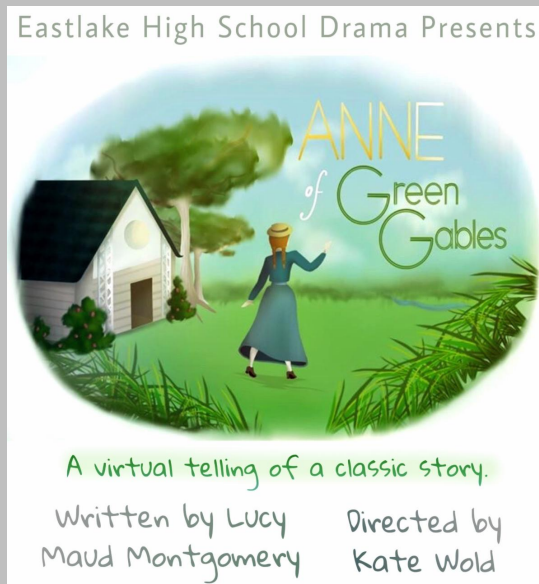
