COMMITTEE REPORTS:

SOCIAL JUSTICE – presented by Matt Scobee – <u>St. Vincent DePaul</u> – there has been a significant increase in the number of calls for help from inside and outside of the Fern Creek area (including calls from other SVDP councils); most of the calls are for assistance with LG&E or Water bills – some who have called have had their utilities turned off; <u>General</u> – working with Representative Bratcher and Senator McGarvey to set up meetings at St. Gabriel; the meetings will be similar to those that occur at a "Catholics at the Capitol" event (hosted by the Catholic Conference of KY in Frankfort during the longer legislative session) and will center around a conversation on the issues that are important to our bishops (i.e. the Catholic Conference of KY); both legislators are running for re-election so it's been decided that we should target a date that is after November 8, 2016; <u>Fern Creek/Highview United Ministries</u> – continuing to organize the annual "FCHUM Thanksgiving Basket" effort – support is strong and several groups have come forward and offered to help
